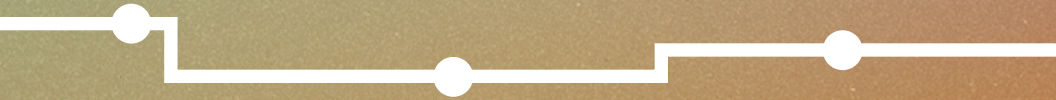

So here's the run down:

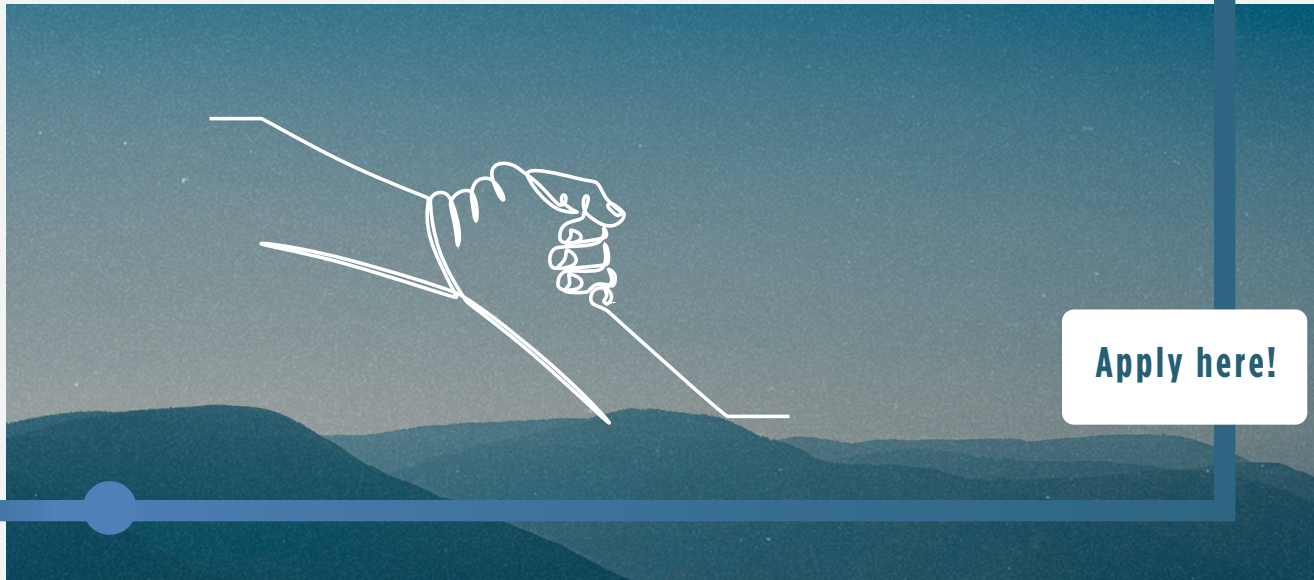

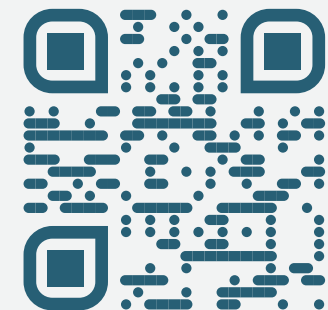

- Camp - Date and Location TBD

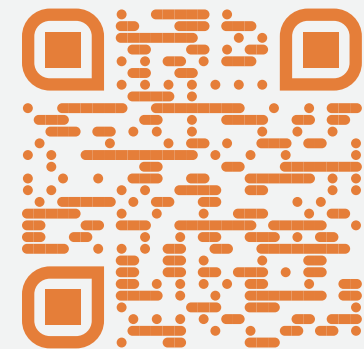
